Year 5

What an exciting term lies ahead for Year 5!

We'll be travelling through time and discovering the mysteries of the universe. In history, we'll learn about what life was like in Tudor times—we'll look at the clothes people wore, how they entertained themselves and what school life was like. Our writing in English will often link with History, writing biographies, poetry and non-chronological reports. In science, we'll learn about solar systems and the movement of the planets. We'll master division skills and fractions specialist in Maths.

Year 6



In this exciting term, we will be discovering how a World War 2 child lived, especially thinking about the local area. Maths will continue to centre around fractions, in addition to decimals and percentages. In English, we will consider poetry, explanation texts and instructions. Our DT will focus on rationing and cooking recipes from wartime. P.E will include gymnastics and Frisbee.

Year 4

This term, Year 4 will be exploring the lives of the Anglo-Saxons! This week Year 4 will be exploring who they were and how they have shaped Britain today. In English, we will begin to look at persuasive adverts and practice using skills in computing to use PowerPoint. We are continuing to look at multiplication in Maths and in Science we are learning about how sounds are made through vibrations. In PE will be doing gymnastics. This term our DT will focus on making a three course meal based on what the Anglo-Saxons would've eaten.

Year 3

This term Year 3 will be discovering Stone age life! We will be learning about the changes in peoples homes, food, lifestyles and many other aspects of the Stone Age – Iron Age! In maths we will continue to learn how to do column addition and subtraction and in science we will be learning about the wonders of rocks and soils! DT will focus on us using a range of tools to create Stone Age products!
